b. <u>Consultation re: draft Report to Council (RTC) - Donation of MacPhail Taxidermy Collection to Stones 'N Bones Museum</u>

Heather Slater shared the draft report to Council regarding the donation of the MacPhail Taxidermy Collection to Stones "N Bones Museum.

Stephanie clarified that the collection belongs to CK Council not the museum and this is a pure donation. Stephanie has been maintaining a regular evaluation of the collection over a period of 15 years and Stones 'N Bones has always met the expectations.
