with Four Counties Transit to provide accessible and affordable door-to-door transportation services for Chatham-Kent residents living in Ward 3 (including Bothwell, Highgate, Thamesville, and Ridgetown).

Trips are available anywhere within the service area which includes West Elgin, Southwest Middlesex and Newbury. Trips outside the service area are available for an extra charge. Four Counties Transit is operated by the Municipality of West Elgin.
