Subject: Hexagon iCAD solution for Next Generation 9-1-1

Recommendation(s)

It is recommended that:

- 1. The Hexagon iCAD licenses and hardware required for the Next Generation 9-1-1 backup site, be sole sourced to Hexagon Safety at a cost of \$142,570.
- The total cost of \$142,570 (including HST) be funded from the NEXTGEN capital budget.
- 3. Annual software maintenance charges of \$13,940 (including HST) be funded from 13903.52171.NG911 existing base budget.
- 4. The Director of Information Technology & Transformation be authorized to negotiate and execute the final contracts and terms with Hexagon Safety, subject to the terms and conditions being acceptable to the General Manager, FBITT and Director of Legal Services.

Background

The Procurement By-law #166-2020 was adopted by Council on December 14, 2020. The Procurement Section 125 – Sole Source states the following:

A direct Award of Contract may be used to purchase Deliverables from Municipal funds if there is only one Supplier that provides the product. Sole Source purchases that meet this criteria must have prior approval authorized by:

- a. The Chief Administrative Officer up to \$100,000.
- b. Council above \$100,000.

The NG9-1-1 Report to Council was received by Council on October 3, 2022, requesting additional budget to deliver the Next Generation 9-1-1(NG9-1-1) project which was subsequently approved. Within the report, details were included pertaining to the requirement of additional Hexagon iCAD licenses and equipment that would be required at the backup site. The need for a backup/secondary location is critical to the resilience of the 9-1-1 service and has previously been agreed by Council.

Chatham-Kent Police Services (CKPS) subscribes to a Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) solution from Hexagon Safety (Hexagon) through a contract with the Ontario Police Technology Information Co-operative (OPTIC). The CAD solution provides complete, integrated capabilities for call handling and dispatching, intelligent mapping, field communications, data reporting and analysis and application integration. iCAD enhances the quality and availability of critical information, providing a common operating picture for intelligent response.

The back up site cannot function without the Hexagon iCAD service. Emergency Call Operators (ECOs) must have the ability to track the location and progress of front-line services during an incident. There is no other alternative solution as this has to be a replication of the existing system.

Comments

The contract with Hexagon would cover all necessary hardware and software, plus professional services, to replicate the CAD environment at the secondary/back up site and allow for full Disaster Recovery services, should the primary Emergency Call Centre be inaccessible. OPTIC provides the primary hosted solution, but the backup licenses would be procured through Hexagon directly as OPTIC does not have the mechanism to invoice for licenses, only subscription services.
